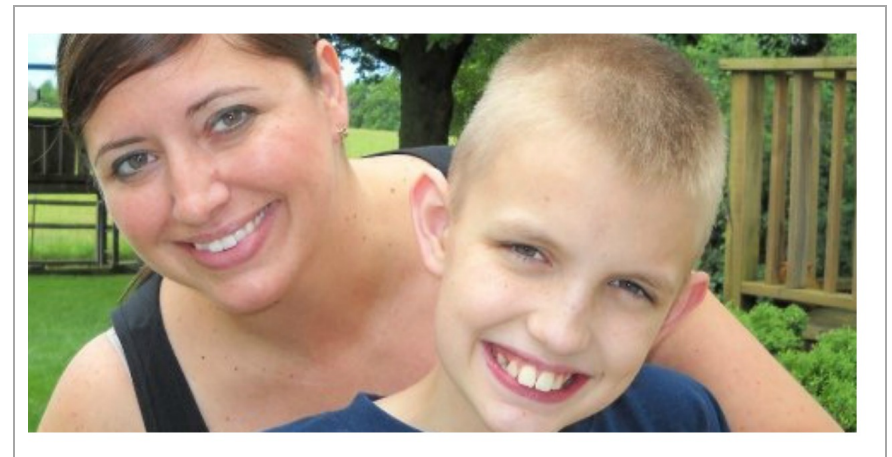

You have the right to: A safe place to live .....	1
You have the right to: Dignity, privacy and humane care .....	1
You have the right to: Prompt medical care and treatment.....	1
You have the right to: Physical exercise & recreation .....	2
You have the right to: Pick out and wear your own clothes .....	2
You have the right to: Religious freedom and practice .....	2

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## YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO SAY "NO".



You have the **right** to say "NO" to things that will put you in danger or things that are against your wishes for your lifestyle.

*You have the **responsibility** to say "NO" to risky activities.*

## YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO KEEP AND SPEND YOUR OWN MONEY.



You have the **right** to carry your money with you when you go shopping and on outings. When you get paid from your job, you have the right to use that money to buy things you want after bills are paid. No one can take your money from you without your consent.

*You have the **responsibility** to budget and pay your bills.*

## YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO ACCESS YOUR RECORDS.



You have the **right** to look at your records. You can ask your case manager or staff to show you your records. Everything that is written about you is available for you to see. If you do not understand something, you have the right to ask someone to explain the meaning to you.

*You have the **responsibility** to understand your records.*

# Your Rights & Responsibilities

## YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO BE FREE FROM HAZARDOUS PROCEDURES.



You have the **right** to refuse any surgery or treatment you do not need. However, if you need emergency treatment because of an accident or other serious injury you will have it done to save your life.

*You have the **responsibility** to clean your space.*

## YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO KEEP AND USE YOUR OWN THINGS.



You have the **right** to keep your own things in a private place that you can get into when you want. No one is allowed to take or use your personal belongings without your permission.

*You have the **responsibility** to keep your items secured.*

## YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO MAKE CHOICES.



You have the **right** to choose where you live, how you want to live, activities you want to participate in, the way you spend your time, food you want to eat and things you want to buy. You have the right to make your own choices and live the life you want to live.

*You have the **responsibility** to choose safe activities and living arrangements.*

## YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO A SAFE PLACE TO LIVE.



You have the **right** to a safe, sanitary and physically adequate place to live. You have the right to live in a clean home (no bugs, no mice, no dirt, no cobwebs).

*You have the **responsibility** to clean your space.*

## YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO DIGNITY, PRIVACY AND HUMANE CARE.



You have the **right** to be treated with dignity and respect. You have the right to have people speak to you in a kind way. They should not shout at you or call you names. They should not hit you or ignore you. If you have a question, they should answer in a nice tone.

*You have the **responsibility** to treat others with respect.*

## YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO PROMPT MEDICAL CARE AND TREATMENT.



You have the **right** to receive medical treatment and have someone give you immediate attention if you are injured or sick. You have the right to know what medications have been prescribed, why they have been prescribed, and any side effects of the medication.

*You have the **responsibility** to report any abuse and refuse to engage in dangerous behaviors.*

## YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO PHYSICAL EXERCISE AND RECREATION.



You have the **right** to participate in regular exercise and activities. You have the right to have fun, participate in sports, dances, and other activities, if you choose.

*You have the **responsibility** to be active and healthy, and learn about activities in the community.*

## YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO PICK OUT AND WEAR YOU OWN CLOTHES.



You have the **right** to wear your own clothes and pick out your own clothes to wear.

*You have the **responsibility** to choose clothes appropriate to the weather, season and activity.*

## YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO RELIGIOUS FREEDOM AND PRACTICE.



You have the **right** to attend or not attend religious services. You have the right to choose to attend a religious location if you want. If you want to be active in your faith community, you can. You can participate as much or as little as you like.

*You have the **responsibility** to respect different faith choices of others.*

## YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO SOCIAL AND COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION



You have the **right** to spend time alone or with a friend. You can meet people and take part in community activities you choose. You can engage in a mutual, romantic relationship with someone.

*You have the **responsibility** to choose and learn about having healthy relationships.*

## YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO BE FREE FROM HARM, ABUSE OR NEGLECT



You have the **right** to be safe and free from physical, emotional and sexual abuse of any kind. You have the right to ask questions and be given answers in a timely manner. No one is allowed to cause you injury or pain on purpose, or ignore you and anything you might need.

*You have the **responsibility** to report any abuse and refuse to engage in dangerous behaviors.*

## YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO SERVICES AND SUPPORTS IN THE LEAST RESTRICTIVE ENVIRONMENT



You have the **right** to receive services and supports in an environment that is least restrictive to meet your needs. No one can put undo restrictions on your lifestyle without your consent.

*You have the **responsibility** to use self control and self-advocacy to live in the environment you want.*
